



7-day sample itinerary to Sweden



Day 1

Start in Stockholm.

Stockholm is called the Venice of Northern Europe. Being a city spread over 14 islands, you can walk by the waterfront and come across many attractions. Visit Vasa Ship Museum or City Hall's famous Blue Hall, site of the annual Nobel Prize banquet. Take in the relaxed pace of Stockholm and its many cafes all over town.

Day 2

Take a guided tour of Stockholm to see the old town Gamla Stan, Djurgården – king's ancient hunting grounds.

In the evening, check out the world-famous – ABSOLUT ICEBAR STOCKHOLM, which is the world's first permanent ice bar, the temperature is a cool -5°C all year round, and the entire interior, including the glasses, is made from 100% pure, clear ice. Isn't that cool?



Day 3

Drive to Falun.

On the way, around the town of Enköping, there are many interesting sights to visit, including the Grönsö Castle as well as a number of medieval churches and Viking Age rock carvings. Further north at Sala, you can take a tour of the old silver mine and visit the mine museum or police museum along with several other craft and souvenir shops.

Day 4

Kids would love the Dalarnas Museum in Falun which is about Swedish folk art, music and culture. Instead of 'Do not touch', it asks visitors to 'Be curious, please touch'.

Continue to Mora, visit the 18th century home and museum of Anders Zorn, one of Sweden's most celebrated painters. Here you can also visit Zorns Gammalgården. Take a short drive north at the Grönklitt Bear Park for nature and wildlife.



Day 5

Drive from Mora to Sunne.

You will be passing many lakes and forests which will make your drive very soothing and relaxing. Carry a picnic basket or eat at small local eateries on the way.

Day 6

Visit Rottneros Park to see its many sculptures.

Near Karlstad, visit the legendary Swedish linen mills. Drive to Örebro and on the way see the 15m Picasso sculpture. In Örebro, see the open-air museum.



Day 7

Visit the many castles on your way back to Stockholm.
